Registration	Register on the day or pre-register on the website (details below).		
Opening Times	All checkpoints are open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. You may find that checkpoints are open a little earlier or later, but remember that people at the checkpoints are volunteers and can't be expected to be there at dawn!		
Island Wide Route Randonnee clockwise	100km route around the whole of the Isle of Wight mainly following the Round-the-Island cycle route and taking minor roads and lanes where possible. It is way-marked by white bicycle on blue island signs. Each cyclist is given a Round-the-Island cycle route map with easy to follow directions to enable the rider to see the best of the Island scenery. Join at any of the checkpoints.		
55km Route Randonnee clockwise	The 55km Randonnee route follows the Round Island Route from East Cowes, through Wootton and Bembridge to Alverstone. It then joins NCN (National Cycle Network) Route 23 from Alverston through Newport to East Cowes. Join at any of the 4 checkpoints (East Cowes, Wootton, Bembridge or Alverston) and follow the diagram on the Checkcard. Read reverse of card for Newport route details in addition to Route 23 stickers.

	East Cowes	SZ 502958	East Cowes Red Funnel Ferry car park. For ferry to/from Southampton.
	Wootton	SZ 551918	Wootton Kite Hill Farm Camp site. Nearest to Wightlink ferry to/from Portsmouth. Follow Randonnee signs to the checkpoint.
	Bembridge	SZ 649877	Bembridge Forelands Middle School, Walls Road. Feeding station c/o PTA. Follow Randonnee signs to school.
	Alverstone	SZ 577857	Alverstone Village Hall
	Whitwell	SZ 523776	Whitwell Village Hall
	Yarmouth	SZ 355896	Yarmouth Primary School. Feeding station c/o PTA. Wightlink Ferry to/from Lymington.
Refreshments	Enjoy the refreshments provided by the PTAs of Bembridge and Yarmouth schools. Riders will be able to purchase soup and a roll, a variety of sandwiches and delicious cakes together with cups of tea, soft drinks etc.		
Certificates	All participants completing the 100km route or the 55km route will receive a Randonnee certificate.		
Badges	At completion, celebrate your success. A badge will be available again this year - Blue Island on Yellow sea.		
Charity	The Randonnee is not set up as a charitable event but as a free entry event. However, the organisers support participants who wish to use the Randonnee as a means of raising money for a good cause. All we ask is that the Randonnee is acknowledged in any media release, and that you inform us of your achievement.		
Emergency Breakdown	Emergency breakdown support provided by Wight Mountain between 10:00 and 17:00. The Service is for bikes or riders that are totally unable to continue. £5 minimum call out fee. Mobile number is 07884168458. Pick-up only, but can transport to nearest checkpoint for minor bike repairs.		
Safety	Cyclists are reminded that this is a fun event and not a race. Please take special attention to the requirements of the Highway Code and show consideration to other road users and pedestrians/horses on shared paths. The Wayfarer Cycle Touring Club (IoW) cannot accept responsibility for injury to or losses from any participant.		
Terms and Conditions of entry	By entering the Randonnee (the event), you (the participant) agree to follow the Highway Code for the duration of the event.
